

## Request for Proposal

The Huron County Airport Authority is taking bids for mowing and landscaping services and snow removal. These services may be bid as a package or separately, mowing/landscaping +/- or snow removal.

No hourly rate bids will be accepted. Bids are to be either "event" based (per mowing/per snow storm clean up) or monthly retainer.

Mowing/landscaping: bids may be submitted based on using the airport's equipment, (tractor, brush hog, weed whip) or bidder's own equipment or combination thereof. Service includes but is not limited to: mowing 60+/- acres, weed whipping, weed abatement. NO grass may be left on any paved or gravel surface.

Snow removal includes but is not limited to: snow removal on runway, 4200' x 75' +/-, aprons and taxiways, around hangar area, office area, Jim Esker Drive and clearing of sidewalks. Snow must be maintained in low piles to accommodate low-wing aircraft. Snow must also be cleared from around runway lights if they become covered. The use of skids is requested. The airport does not have snow removal equipment.
